Type and nature of the scholarships


- 1. 100% tuition waiver.
- The duration of the Award will cover the normal duration of the programme only. If the student exceeds the normal duration of the programme, he/she may need to bear the extra tuition fees incurred.
- The student must show satisfactory academic performance throughout the programme as per the ULAB policy. The scholarship may be terminated by the University at any time if the conduct or progress of the student is found unsatisfactory.

Degree Level

- 1. Merit based scholarships are applicable for exclusively to the undergraduate degree programmes.
- 2. The freedom-fighters' children can apply for both the undergraduate and the graduate programmes.

- Students must obtain GPA 5.0 (preferably Golden GPA) in both their HSC and SSC exams.
- 2. Students must be recommended by their respective college Principals.
